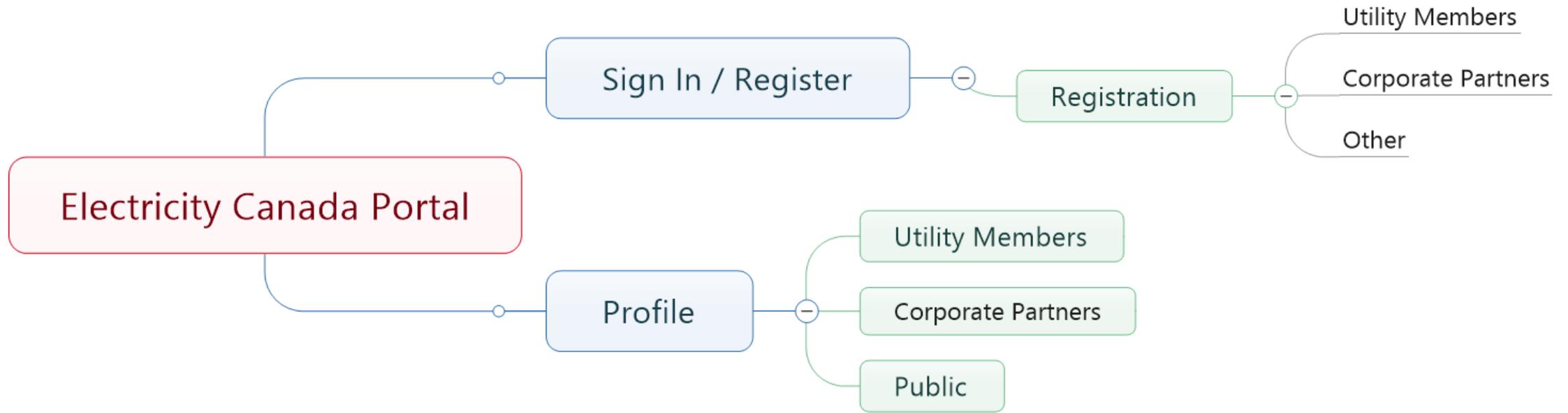
Scenario One – CEA Member Portal Assessment

- **Review and provide recommendations around:**

 - Data Portal – a series of databases, reports and visualizations on multiple platforms
- **The following high-level goals were established:**
 - Single Sign-on for All Applications
 - Address Duplication of Entry Issues and Contact Management
 - Moving to the Cloud (eliminating on-premises infrastructure)
 - Single Data Platform (Reporting)
 - Cybersecurity

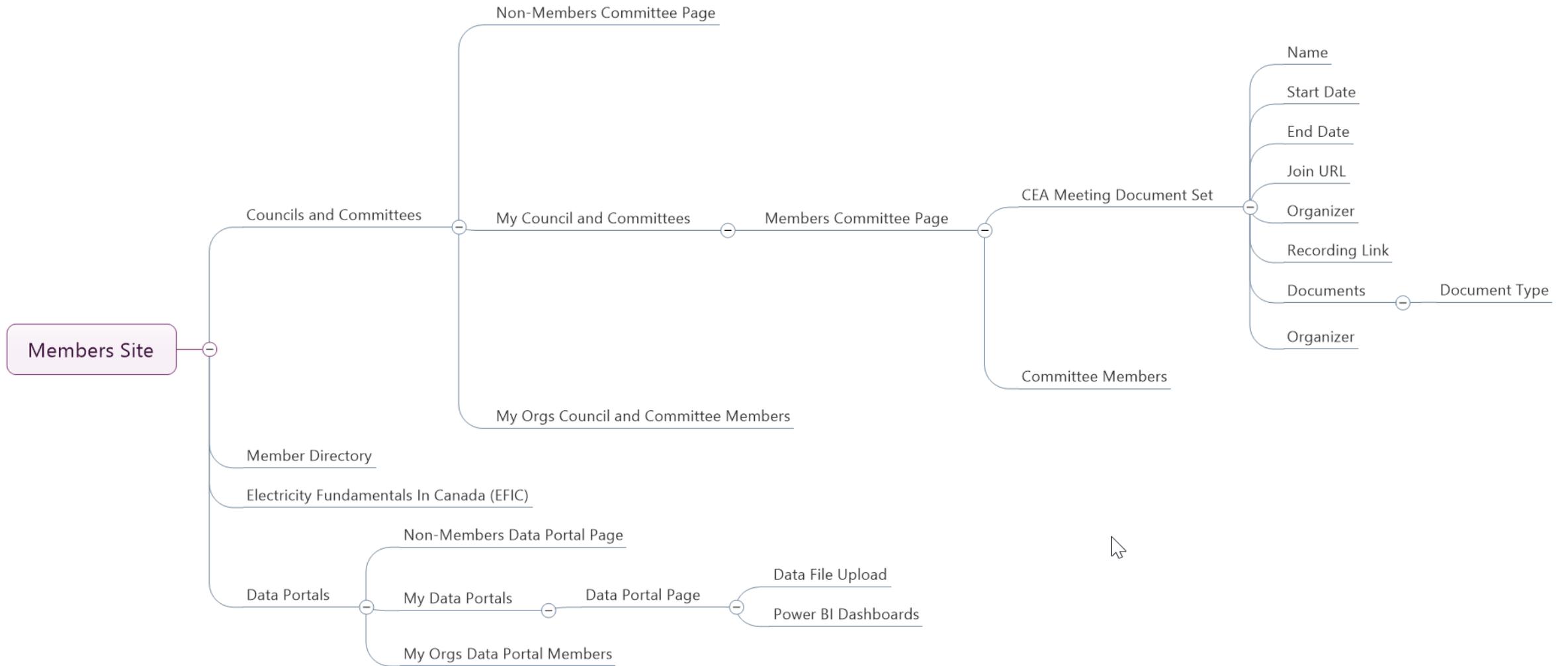

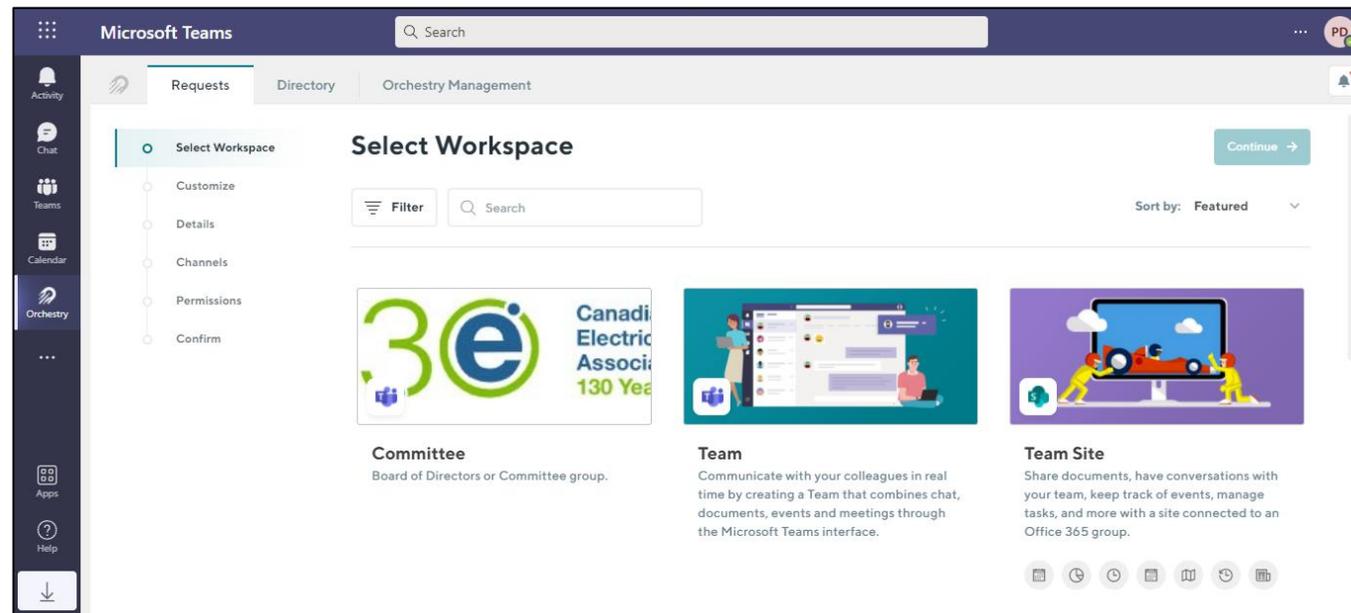

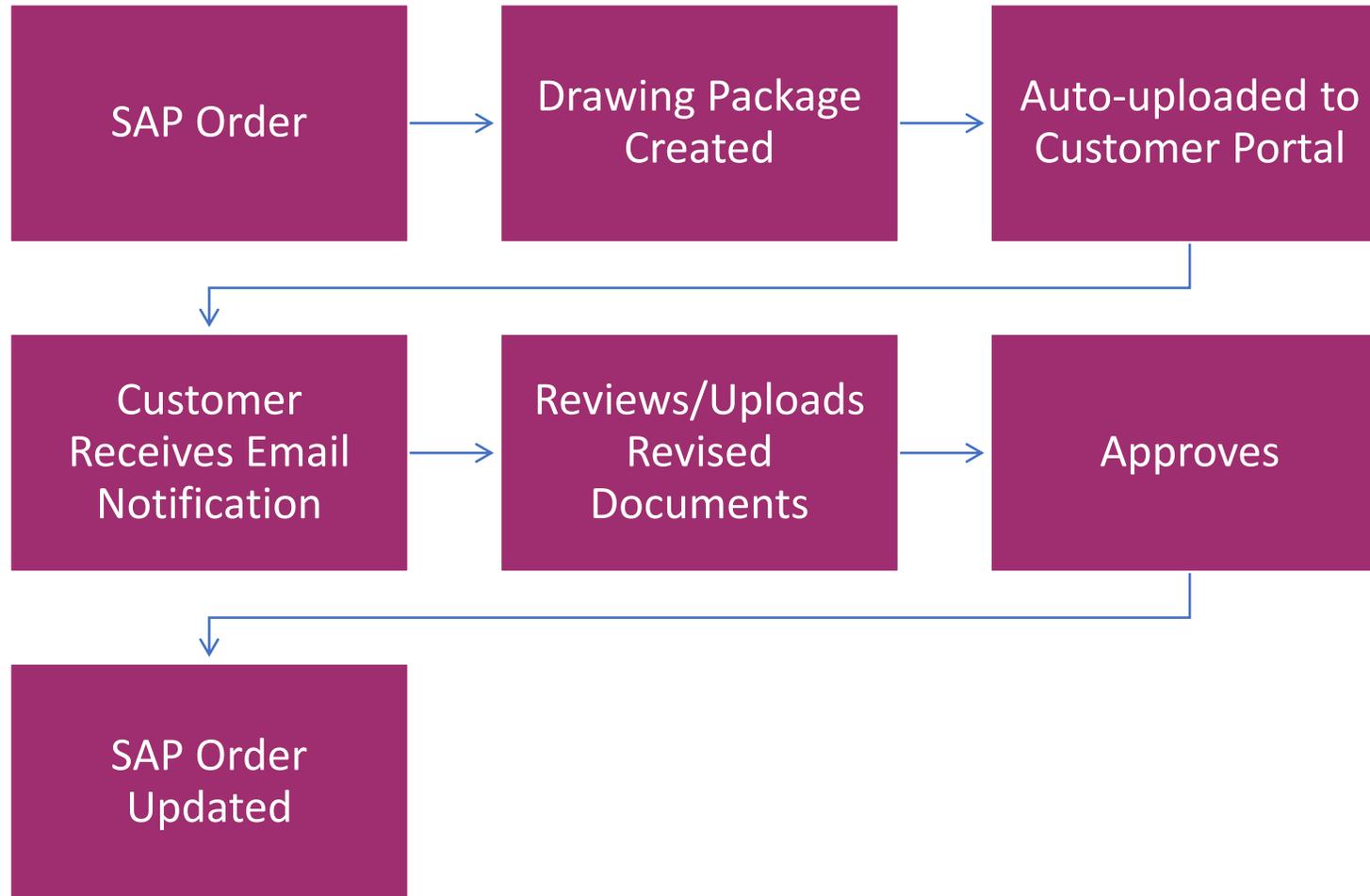


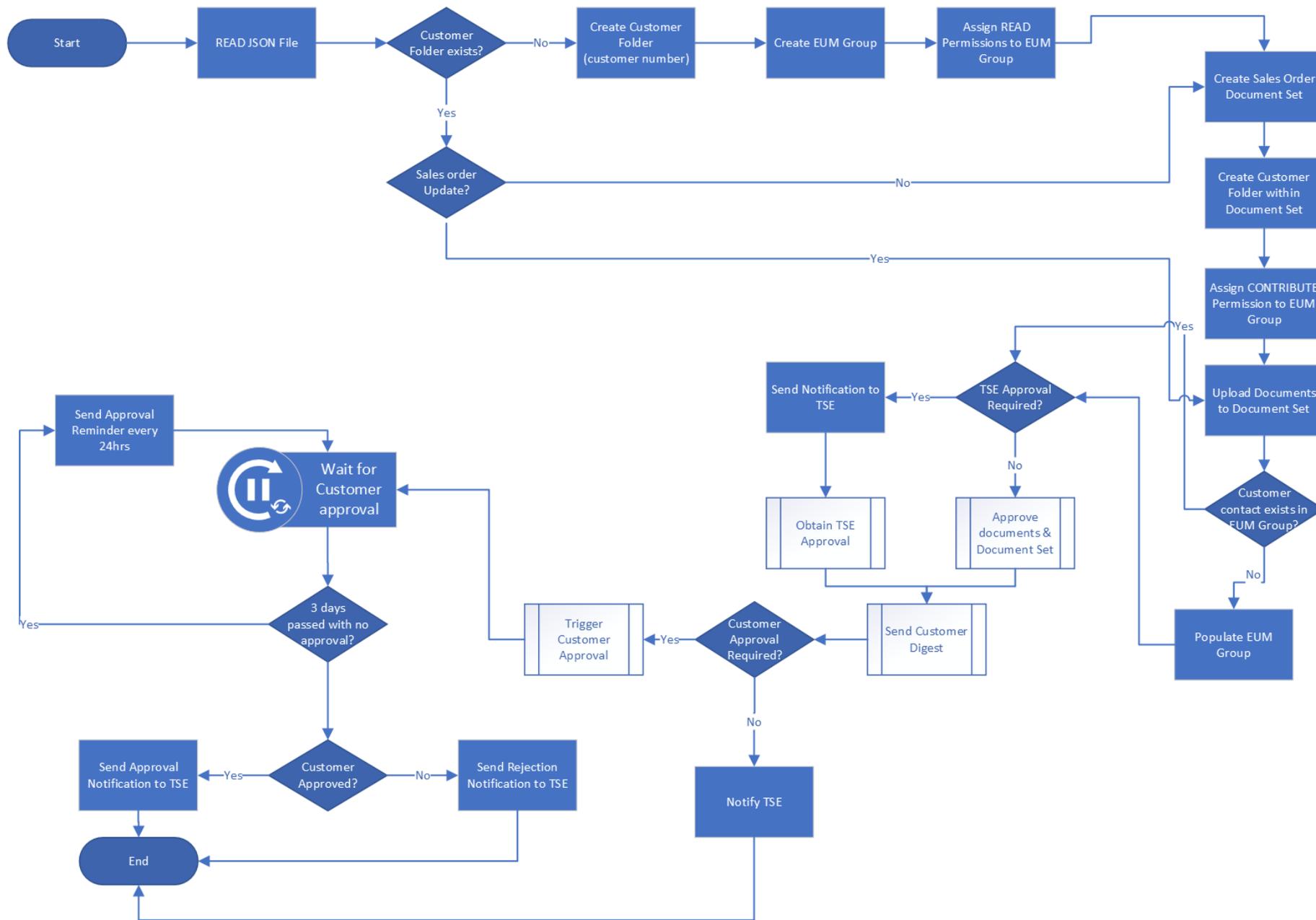
Scenario Three – Mold Masters: Engineering Extranet

- **Automation of drawing package preparation**
- **Workflow for approvals**
 - Internal engineering approval may be required first
 - Customer notification and approval
 - Reminder notifications
 - Approval completion updates SAP order status
- **Ability for customer to upload annotated or additional documents**

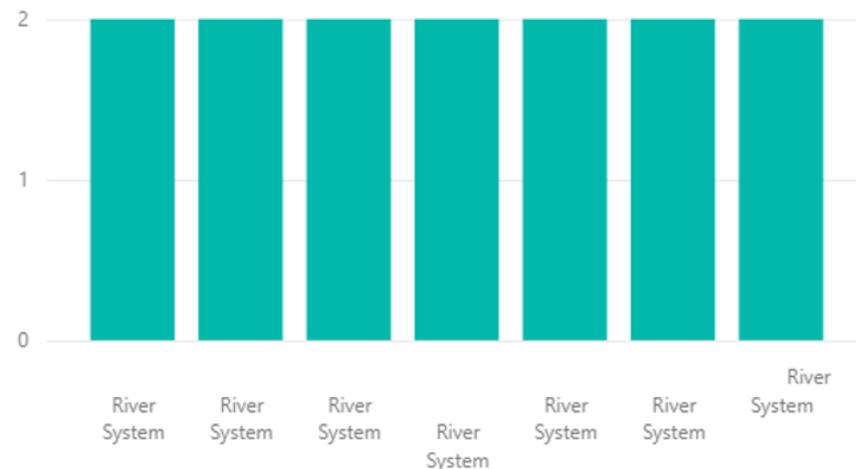

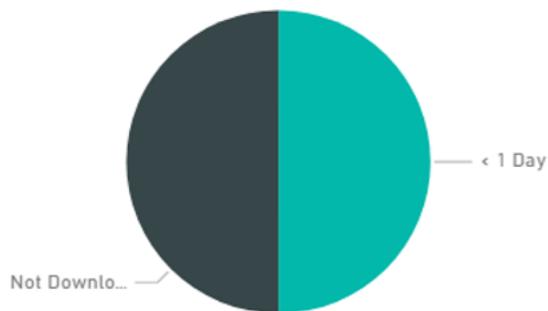

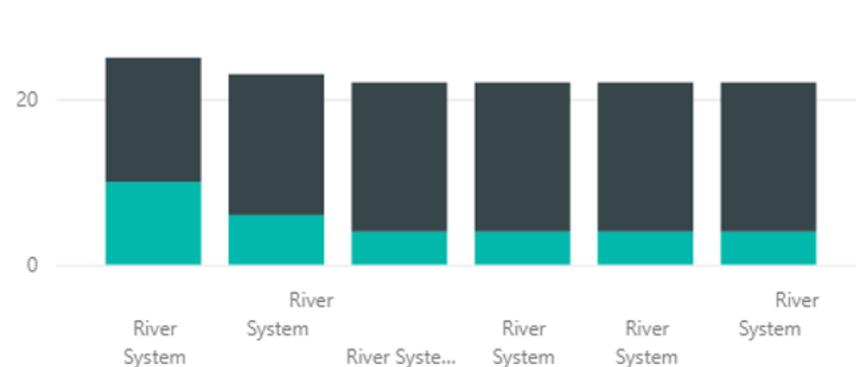

- **Parent organization with dozens of subsidiaries**
 - Publicly traded
 - Subsidiaries are their own legal entities with independent financial reporting
- **Monthly, quarterly, annual, and audit reporting packages**
 - Strict schedules to collect, review, and roll up
- **Finance staff at subsidiaries may be responsible for one or multiple subsidiaries**

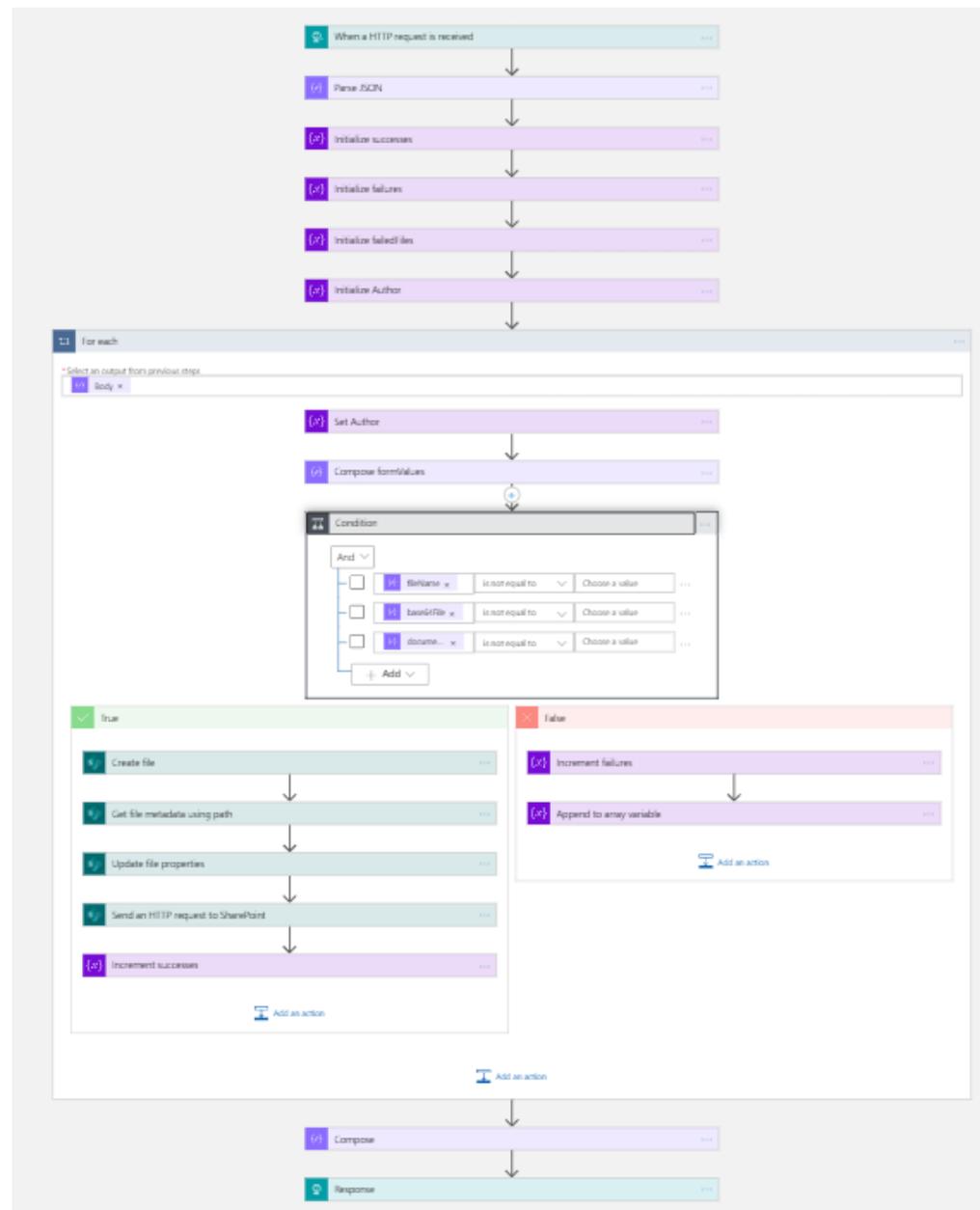

- Sits on top of SharePoint Online
 - Version history
 - Meta-data tagging
- Document Sets are used to separate document packages
- Meta-data defines user rules

- Generate rollups and related images

- **Groups created in EUM can provide access to SharePoint sites, Teams, Document libraries, etc.**
